Sparkling

Cantina De Pra Prosecco Brut 11 44

Treviso, IT 🍷 Glera (W)

Vintage Prosecco crafted by leading women winemakers of Treviso. A drier style with flavors of tart green apple, passion fruit, and white flowers.

McBride Sisters Sparkling Brut Rosé 12 48

Hawkes Bay, NZ 🍷 Pinot Noir (b) (W)

From the largest Black-owned wine brand in the US, founded by two sisters from opposite sides of the world: Monterey and New Zealand. Lively mousse, fresh red currant, with a touch of savory biscuit on the finish.

Equality Vines "Love Wins" Sparkling Blanc de Blanc 70

Russian River Valley, CA 🍷 Chardonnay (Q)

From our friends at Equality Vines, commemorating the 2015 Obergefell Supreme Court ruling. Benefits Raise a Child, which advocates for LGBTQ+ adoption. This méthode champenoise rivals some of the best Champagnes with broad aromas of ripe pears and orange blossoms with a luscious mousse.

Thiénot Brut Champagne NV (375ml) 48

Reims, FR 🍷 Pinot Meunier/Pinot Noir/Chardonnay

Sourced from some of the best sites in Champagne; light and delicate Bosc pear with marzipan.

B. Stuyvesant Brut Rosé Champagne 375ml 52

Champagne, FR 🍷 Chardonnay/Pinot Noir/Pinot Meunier (b) (W)

One of the only Black woman-owned Champagne houses, with a name alluding to Marvina Robinson's hometown, Brooklyn. Red currants and fresh strawberry with crisp and refreshing acidity. The mouthfeel is generous with juicy raspberries on the palate.

Louis Roederer "Collection 243" Brut Champagne 140

Champagne, FR 🍷 Pinot Noir/Pinot Meunier/Chardonnay

Celebrating the 243rd harvest of Champagne's top producer. Baked apples with crème fraîche and subtle white flowers.

Light and Aromatic Whites

Chateau Goudichaud Sauvignon Blanc 12 48

Bordeaux, FR 🍷 Sauvignon Blanc/Muscadelle/Sémillon (W)

Women run and owned company, producing a classic example of Bordeaux Blanc. Citrus fruit dominated; yuzu and pomelo with a tiny bit of lemongrass.

Portal Garnatxa Blanca 15 60

Terra Alta, ES 🍷 Garnacha Blanca (Q)

Nuanced layers of bright citrus and stone fruits with a racy mineral backbone. The palate holds tension between tight acidity and an unctuous textural quality. A proudly queer-run winery.

Dominique Roger "Domaine du Carrou" Sancerre '21 68

Sancerre, FR 🍷 Sauvignon Blanc (W)

Sourced from small parcels in the village of Bué. 25+ year-old vines grown in prized slate-rich soils gives its distinct minerality. This savory backbone balances the ripe grapefruit and yellow citrus notes. Made in stainless steel with native yeasts.

Rich, Full-Bodied Whites

Terah Wine Co. Falanghina 14 56

Clarksburg, CA 🍷 Falanghina (Q) (W)

From a local queer winemaker of Iranian descent. Grown just outside Sacramento in the silt soils of the delta, this Italian varietal thrives in this cool climate. The grapes see twelve days of skin contact, with zero additives; this is also a natural wine.

Gary Farrell "Olivet Lane Vineyard" Chardonnay '19 90

Russian River Valley, CA 🍷 Chardonnay (Q) (W)

Top-100 winery in the world two years in a row thanks to lesbian winemaker Theresa Heredia, and considered a "grand cru" of CA. Restrained oak notes, with tart yellow orchard fruits and white flowers. Reminiscent of the best Burgundies.

Rosé

Elena Walch 10/26 Rosé 14 56

Alto Adige, IT 🍷 Pinot Noir/Merlot/Teroldego (W)

Delicate pink with a touch of fuchsia, juicy cranberries and pomegranate; extremely bright and acid-driven crafted by icon of the region Elena Walch and her daughters. Grown in the high alpine vineyards of the Dolomites.

Light and Juicy Reds

Bosman “Nature & Sun” Grenache Noir 15 60

Western Cape, SA 🍷 Grenache Noir (b)

A fascinating light-bodied wine, with complex layers of red fruits, dried orange, and chamomile. Black winemaker Natasha Williams leads this 26% Black-owned winery founded in the 18th Century.

Sheild New Zealand Pinot Noir 14 56

Nelson, NZ 🍷 Pinot Noir (W)

Beautiful violet aromas with fresh raspberries and cassis with a structured, dark-fruited palate. Sourced from a vineyard managed by the Maori tribe, crafted by leading winemaker Trudy Sheild.

Hirsch Vineyards “The Bohan-Dillon” Pinot Noir ‘19 90

Sonoma Coast, CA 🍷 Pinot Noir (W)

Ripe strawberries, pine nettles and extremely perfumed. Predominantly estate fruit from a highly sought after producer.

Fog Crest Estate Pinot Noir ‘18 130

Russian River Valley, CA 🍷 Pinot Noir (Q) (b) (W)

An exquisite example of the finest Sonoma pinots. A seamless mouthfeel that has delicate tannins and explosive flavors. Bing cherry, dried cranberries, roses and quince. Black-owned, and gay crafted, from their coveted estate vineyard.

Medium-Bodied Reds

Viñedos del Contino Rioja Reserva ‘17 96

Laserna-Laguardia, ES 🍷 Tempranillo/Graciano/Mazuelo (Q) (W)

Pioneers of single vineyard Rioja, Contino is a women-run winery, uniquely nestled on three sides by the Ebro river with an average vine age of 75 years. Raspberry and plum flavors flanked with anise, orange zest; focused and fresh mineral notes.

Martinelli “Vigneto di Evo” Zinfandel ‘18 68

Russian River Valley, CA 🍷 Zinfandel

Strawberry preserves with a touch of florality; old school Sonoma producers, famous for zinfandel.

Bold, Full-Bodied Reds

Viña Real Rioja Crianza 13 52

Laserna-Laguardia, ES 🍷 Tempranillo (W)

From the iconic CVNE family of wines, an all women run wine empire representing Spain’s best vineyards. This elegant example of Rioja has crunchy red and blue fruits balanced with a spice backbone on the palate.

Collosorbo Brunello di Montalcino ‘17 90

Montalcino, IT 🍷 Sangiovese (W)

From a women-run winery and named one of the top 50 wines of 2021. Savory red fruits with pinch of spice, bright acid keeps the finish long and mouthwatering.

Clos des Brusquieres Chateauf-neuf-du-Pape ‘20 98

Châteauf-neuf-du-Pape, FR 🍷 Grenache/Syrah/Mourvèdre/Cinsault (W)

This tiny, family run estate in the Brusquieres lieu-dit only makes one wine, putting all of their energy into making it the best it can be. Extremely aromatic, dark berries and allspice with an iron-like minerality that is simultaneously bold yet elegant.

Edge Cabernet Sauvignon 16 64

Alexander Valley, CA 🍷 Cabernet Sauvignon (b) (W)

From Indian winemaker Priyanka French, a rising star and fierce champion of diversity in the industry. Rich and elegant, with playful fruit qualities balanced by savory smoky barbecue.

Stag’s Leap “Artemis” Cabernet Sauvignon 140

Napa Valley, CA 🍷 Cabernet Sauvignon

Famous for winning the formative 1976 Judgement of Paris, ranking high above the best Bordeaux’s and other Napa Cabernet Sauvignons. Rich and velvety cocoa and cassis, kalamata olive, espresso with velvety tannins.

Theopolis Vineyards Petite Sirah ‘19 86

Yorkville Highlands, CA 🍷 Petite Sirah (Q) (b) (W)

From celebrated Black winemaker Theodora Lee, a.k.a. “Theopatra, Queen of the Vineyards.” Rich and velvety, with notes of blueberry pie, black fruits, and a touch of eucalyptus.
